



Lime-B-Gone

LIME & SCALE REMOVER

ABOUT THIS PRODUCT

Lime-B-Gone scale remover is a concentrated acidic liquid for use in dish machines to dissolve light to medium scale buildup. It contains surfactant and emulsifiers to penetrate and remove lime and other difficult deposits. It is also recommended for use on food service equipment such as: stainless steel, steam tables, food preparation equipment and coffee urns.

DIRECTIONS

Automatic Dish Machines:

1. Drain and clean out dish machine.
2. Set machine dispenser to the DELIME setting or cycle.
3. Close drain valve and fill tank with hot water.
4. Add Lime-B-Gone at 4-8 oz. per gallon of water.
5. Allow machine to run until lime deposits can be brushed or flushed away.
6. Rinse away residual lime deposits and drain tank.
7. Set dish machine to the RUN setting or cycle and use dish machine as normal.
8. For excessive lime buildup, pour ½ to 1 gallon of Lime-B-Gone into the wash tank and allow machine to run on the delime cycle.

Ice Machines: Leave pump operating but turn off refrigerator unit if possible. Drain unit and refill with water. Dilute Lime-B-Gone 32 oz. to 2/3 gallon of water. Add diluted cleaner to unit. Allow to circulate for about 45 minutes. If cleaner does not cover all surfaces, use clean bowl mop to coat all surfaces with solution. If scale is extra heavy, increase amount of cleaner up to one part Lime-B-Gone to one part water. After cleaning, drain unit a flush with clean water. Lime-B-Gone can be used as a hard surface delimer when diluted 2 to 4 oz. per gallon. Simply spray diluted mixture onto lime scale buildup, allow it to penetrate, and wipe off.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Prevention: Keep only in original container. Do not breathe dusts or mists. Wash skin thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection.
